REGISTRATION

- Pre-registration with a \$2 fee is available at local Bike Shops. Day of event registration at the South Washington Street Bridge is from 8am to 9am with a \$3 fee.
- Start the ride at South Washington Street Bridge and pedal alongside the Susquehanna and Chenango Rivers, landmark bridges, see historic sites, and rest at local parks.
- Parking is available on Conklin Avenue. The McKinney Real Estate parking lot (21 South Washington St.) is also available, but please do not use the spaces closest to the building.
- Tour guides from several transportation, cultural, historic, and community organizations will be at the event to speak about these special historic bridges, local parks, and City landmark places.

RIDE RULES

- All ride participants must wear a bicycle helmet and the Binghamton Bridge Pedal wrist band. You will receive the wrist band when you register.
- Children riding in trailers or on bike seats ride free. They need not register, but they must wear a bicycle helmet.
- Both riders on tandem bicycles and tag-along bicycles must register.
- Dogs are not allowed on the Binghamton Bridge Pedal ride.
- Stay with the ride group and follow the police escort.
- Remember to stay hydrated.
